Radnor, Sacred Heart lead fabulous river runs for locals

In girls' crew action, **Radnor** entered five boats in Sunday's Philadelphia Scholastic Rowing Association's 3rd Manny Flick/Horvat Series regatta. The Freshmen 4 boat, featuring Celia Parkin, Joelle Khouri, Meghan Gerber, Kathryn Tadduni and Abby Raichek (coxswain), placed first in its race with a comfortable 12-second lead over the second-place boat.

The day before, Radnor participated in the Shoebie Cup at the Whitemarsh Boat Club in Conshohocken. Mount St. Joseph and the Mainland Regional High School (New Jersey) teams hosted the annual event in which six girls' clubs competed. Radnor entered six boats and

placed third overall in the day's events.

The two Radnor Junior Varsity 4 boats were the only ones to make it to finals with the JV 4 boat, including Kendall Chapin, Taylor Olsen, Kristen Mancuso, Emma Howard and Allie Janiczek (coxswain), placing first.

Sacred Heart also took to the Schuylkill River Sunday to begin its 2010 season. The JV 4X, with junior Patty Price in stroke and sophomores Kelsey Williar, Taylor Brady and bow Alex McNulty bolted down the river to capture the team's initial first-place finish of the day.

In the Varsity 2X, seniors Emily Burrichter and Grace Scorzetti captured an additional first-place finish.

The Lightweight Varsity 2X of sophomore Tyler Mitchell and senior Giana Schena took second place.

It was a great race day for Sacred Heart's JV 4X and Varsity 2X boats. The JV 4X sandwiched Springside with first- and third-place finishes in its heat. In first place was bow Alex McNulty and teammates Kelsey Williar, Taylor Brady and Patty Price. They were followed by teammates Jordan Cech, Caroline Greenwald, Elise Gerardi and Tyler Mitchell.

The Lightweight Varsity 2X team of seniors Giana Schena and Colleen McClatchy rowed hard to pull ahead of Baldwin to finish first while the Varsity

2X of seniors Emily Burrichter and Grace Scorzetti slipped into second behind Strath Haven.

Also at Manny Flick, **Harriton's** Novice 4+ hit the water competing for the first time this season, landing in first place with a time of 6:31.67 – a remarkable 7.67 second lead over second-place Germantown Academy. Rowers Emma Butler (stroke), Devon Kelly, Natalie Schade, Lauren Tonetti and coxswain Emily Hirshorin joined six other Harriton boats on the river.

Harriton's Girls' JV 4+, with coxswain Emily Castelbaum, rowers Ali Grady (stroke), Rebecca Jacobs, Rachel Marx and Cara Conwell, placed fourth in its heat and eighth overall out of 16 boats. In a very close race, it was just .03 of a second behind Upper Merion A and .03 ahead of Upper Merion B.

Two Harriton Girls' Varsity 4+ boats competed against 12 others, with rowers Eliza Brooks (stroke), Katherine Kanehahn, Sylvie Kraus, Alison Frank and coxswain Danielle DiStefano placing second in their heat and fourth overall. Harriton's second boat, coxed by Hilary Goldberg, with rowers Tory Zuzelo (stroke), Jen Margulies, Gabrielle Kursman-Neri and Emily Dvorchak, placed third in their heat and eighth overall with a 3-second lead over Episcopal Academy.

Agnes Irwin had a solid showing at the third Manny Flick race. The Freshman 8+ came in fifth place and both

The Varsity 4+ and Varsity 8+ boasted the best results for the team Sunday with the Varsity 4+ of senior captain Kirah Tabourn, senior Nimet Cebeci, junior

Samantha SchafFrank, sophomore / Magnani and junior Lindley Smith winning its race by 4 seconds, which is water on the rest of the field.
